It may not deliberate on the matters brought forward because those items have not been posted; however, the Council may decide to place the item(s) on a future agenda. The Mayor may limit the speaking time in order to provide sufficient time for all inquiries.

This meeting will focus on District 4, the boundaries of which are: North – Spring Creek; South – City's Limit; East – Alma; and to the West, Coit (from Spring Creek to Parker) and Ohio (from Parker to southern City's Limit).
