The Plano Police Department is now hiring for the position of Police Officer. To become a police officer, all applicants must first successfully pre-register for, and then pass, a Civil Service Entrance Examination. Our next Police Entrance Exam will take place at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 27, 2010, at the Plano Senior High School, Building C, which is located at 2200 Independence Parkway, Plano, Texas. The deadline to register for this test is noon on March 11, 2010, and applications cannot be accepted after this date under any circumstances. We are an equal opportunity employer and encourage all interested applicants to apply.

Plano Police Department is the largest law enforcement agency in the northern Dallas metropolitan area, serving more than 263,000 citizens. We are a nationally accredited law enforcement agency with strong community partnership values.
