- Have you registered on [MyTMRS](#) so that you can review your pertinent information? (detailed article in this issue)
- If you turn age 65 this year, have you marked your calendar to talk with Social Security Administration three (3) months prior to your 65th birthday?

I hope this planted a few suggestions for you this spring.



Don't forget...

Frequently visit the Retirement Center folder on the city's homepage, www.plano.gov. Click on Departments, Human Resources, and then Retirement Center located on the left of the screen. We continue to post updates, notices and other retirement related information to the site. You can also find contact information for retirement related benefits including links to TMRS, Social Security and more. Keep in mind that in going "green" we no longer generate paper materials but instead post to the Retirement Center for everyone to read at their leisure. This also gives all of us the opportunity to save a few trees. The information remains on the website for retirees to view as often as they like eliminating the need to have a paper copy.

WOW...

did you know you can have access to your:

- Address on file
- How you receive your monthly payments
- Year-to-date payment information including withholding
- Insurance payments made to date (if you are eligible for the HELPS program)
- Monthly net payment
- Beneficiary(ies) information
- TMRS forms for retirees

All you need to do is follow these steps:

1. Go to www.TMRS.com
2. Click on MyTMRS
3. Register for MyTMRS (you'll receive an e-mail verification within minutes)
4. Log in to MyTMRS using your chosen user name and password
5. View your account information

Address and phone number changes as well as direct deposit changes require completion of the applicable TMRS form, found on the TMRS site.
