Having working smoke alarms in your home cuts your chances of dying in a house fire by 50 percent! If you have smoke alarms, but they don't work, they cannot protect you. Here are some reasons why it is important for every household to have working smoke alarms:

- 85% of all fire deaths occur in the home and most of them happen at night when most people are asleep. Smoke alarms provide the warning that fire and smoke are present. This warning can help you escape safely.
- 40% of home fire deaths happen in homes without smoke alarms. Another 23% happen in homes with smoke alarms that do not work.
- When smoke alarms fail to sound, it is usually because there are missing, dead or disconnected batteries.
