- WASH AFTER CONTACT WITH PETS ~ Fecal matter may not be visible
- SHOWER FIRST ~ Decrease the bacteria load before swimming
- TAKE YOUR CHILD TO THE RESTROOM EVERY HOUR ~
Don't wait for them to ask
- WASH YOUR HANDS AND CHILDREN'S HANDS OFTEN ~
Especially after using the restroom
- POOL WATER IS FOR SWIMMING, NOT DRINKING
- DON'T SWIM IF YOU HAVE DIARRHEA
