**T**he City of Plano adopted a Water Management Plan designed for ongoing, long-term water savings. Simply put, we plan to do the following:

- Reduce water consumption.
- Reduce the loss and waste of water.
- Improve water efficiency.
- Extend current water supplies by reducing future demand.

## *How will the City of Plano do it?* **With YOUR help...**

1. Support Landscape Water Conservation by:
  - Restricting irrigation and watering between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., April through October.
  - Irrigating only twice per week between April and October.
  - Restricting excess water flow onto adjacent property or public right-of-way.
  - Stop watering impervious surfaces, such as concrete.
  - Maintaining irrigation systems.
2. Establish a reduction goal – each resident pledging to reduce their use by 5 percent over the next five years.



## *Under the Water Management Plan, the City of Plano will:*

1. Track water use and control losses from illegal diversions and leaks.
2. Continue to educate and inform residents about how to save water and why it's so important to our community's future.
3. Continue structuring utility rates to encourage water conservation and discourage waste.
4. Implement water conservation strategies throughout City of Plano facilities.
