NOTICE OF MEETING

ONE OR MORE MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF PLANO CITY COUNCIL WILL HOLD A NEIGHBORHOOD ROUNDTABLE ON MAY 19, 2011 BEGINNING AT 7:00 P.M., AT PLANO SPORTS AUTHORITY STARCENTER, 2ND LEVEL LARGE MEETING ROOM, 6500 PRESTON MEADOW, IN PLANO, TEXAS.

The purpose of the meeting is to present information and answer questions regarding city services and programs on the following topics:

- FY 2010-2011 Budget Forecast
- Economic Development Progress Report
- Community Investment Projects (CIP) – District 3
 - Spring Creek/Independence intersection status report
 - Spring Creek/Custer intersection status report
- Improvements/Street Repairs – District 3
- Carpenter Park Recreation Center Update

The Council will receive public comment and inquiry on items of interest that are not posted on the current agenda. Council and/or staff may respond to those items with factual information or recitation of existing policy related to the inquiry or comment. It may not deliberate on the matters brought forward because those items have not been posted; however, the Council may decide to place the item(s) on a future agenda. The Mayor may limit the speaking time in order to provide sufficient time for all inquiries.

This meeting will focus on the Council District 3 area which is bounded by City's Limit on the north, Spring Creek Parkway on the south, and Coit on the west. The eastern boundary of District 3 is the City's Limit north of Hedgcoxe. South of Hedgcoxe, the eastern boundary of District 3 is Alma Road.

The Plano Sports Authority StarCenter is wheelchair accessible. Sloped curb entries are available at the main entrances to the north and west, with specially marked parking spaces nearby.
