The Council will receive public comment and inquiry on items of interest that are not posted on the current agenda. Council and/or staff may respond to those items with factual information or recitation of existing policy related to the inquiry or comment. It may not deliberate on the matters brought forward because those items have not been posted; however, the Council may decide to place the item(s) on a future agenda. The Mayor may limit the speaking time in order to provide sufficient time for all inquiries.

This meeting will concentrate on the Council District 1 area which is bounded by City's Limit on the north, City's Limit on the south, and City's Limit on the east. The western boundary is Alma Road.
