

PLANO CITY COUNCIL

WILL CONVENE INTO SPECIAL CALLED SESSION AT 4:30 P.M., FEBRUARY 25, 2005, IN THE PLANO MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 1520 K AVENUE, IN COMPLIANCE WITH VERNON'S TEXAS CODES ANNOTATED, GOVERNMENT CODE CHAPTER 551 (OPEN MEETINGS ACT), AS FOLLOWS:

Mission Statement: The mission of the City of Plano is to provide outstanding services and facilities, through cooperative efforts with our citizens, that contribute to the quality of life in our community.

Special Called Session

- I. Consideration and direction regarding presentation of a petition and proposed resolution received from Jack Lagos on February 21, 2005 calling for a proposition to be placed on a ballot in the next election: To determine that the citizens of Plano should have the opportunity to ratify or not ratify the City of Plano's portion of financing a performing arts center that is to be built outside the City limits of Plano and is to be shared by two additional municipalities.

In accordance with the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, during Preliminary Open Meetings, agenda items will be discussed and votes may be taken where appropriate. The City Council may convene into Executive Session to discuss posted items in the special called session as allowed by law.

Municipal Center is wheelchair accessible. A sloped curb entry is available at the main entrance facing Avenue L, with specially marked parking spaces nearby. Access and special parking are also available on the north side of building. The Council Chamber is accessible by elevator to the lower level.
