THE **CITY OF PLANO CITY COUNCIL** WILL HOLD A NEIGHBORHOOD ROUNDTABLE ON NOVEMBER 20, 2008 BEGINNING AT 7:00 P.M., AT THE TOM MUEHLENBECK RECREATION CENTER, AT 5801 W. PARKER ROAD, PLANO, TEXAS.

The Council will receive public comment and inquiry on items of interest that are not posted on the current agenda. Council and/or staff may respond to those items with factual information or recitation of existing policy related to the inquiry or comment. It may not deliberate on the matters brought forward because those items have not been posted; however, the Council may decide to place the item(s) on a future agenda. The Mayor may limit the speaking time in order to provide sufficient time for all inquiries.

This meeting will focus on the Council District 2 area which is bounded by the City's Limit on the north, the City's Limit on the south, and the City's Limit on the west. The eastern boundary is at Coit (from northern City's Limit to Parker Road) and at Ohio (from Parker Road to southern City's Limit).
