Throughout the latter part of 2006, the NTMWD sent the Member Cities the water consumption figures for each month. This information compared the monthly consumptions against a theoretical allocation. The consumption figures for 2006 were as follows:

It should also be noted that an analysis of the City of Plano's pumping figures through April reveal that we have used approximately 900 million gallons less through April 2007 than we did for the same period in 2006.
