## Plano Shelter Neuters Cats for 5¢ on Feb. 28

In honor of Spay Day USA, the City of Plano Animal Services Division will neuter male cats for just a nickel on Tuesday, Feb. 28 at the Plano Animal Shelter, 4028 W. Plano Parkway. Appointments are required and space is limited to 100 cats for the day.

All cats must be delivered in a pet carrier that is labeled with the owner's name. Owners must provide written proof of the cat's current rabies and FVRCP vaccinations, or they can be administered for \$9.95 for one shot or \$19.95 for both. Microchip implantation will also be available for an additional \$15 fee per cat. Plano residents will be required to register their cats with the City's Animal Services Division for \$10 or \$5 if the owner is a senior citizen or has proof of being low-income. Spay Day USA originated through the Doris Day Animal Foundation and is now an annual campaign by The Humane Society of the United States. Neutering and spaying is essential to reducing pet overpopulation. Cats can produce up to two litters per year and have a 10-year breeding life. Uncontrolled breeding can eventually lead to an abundance of cats with not enough people to love and care for them. Do your part – *spay or neuter your cat.*
