

HOSPITAL EMERGENCY RELEASE FORM

All Cimarron Camp participants must complete an Emergency Release Form which can be obtained at the hospital of your choice. The form must be notarized to be valid and returned to the Emergency Room desk. The form will remain on file until the child turns 18 years of age.

For your information, in a non life-threatening emergency, the child may be taken to the parent's choice of facility which will be obtained from the campers medical card on file at the camp. If a life-threatening emergency occurs, The City of Plano emergency system will transport to the nearest facility regardless of parent's choice.

If you have already completed a form in the past, there is no need to fill out another form unless medical information on your child needs to be updated.



WHAT TO WEAR & BRING

1. Dress as cool and comfortable as possible. Sturdy shoes and socks are recommended. **No sandals please!**
2. Campers will BRING A SACK LUNCH each day to camp. Please write the camper's name on the lunch box. Camp provides ice water to drink, or you may send a non-carbonated drink.
3. If your child must take medication during the day, it must be kept and dispensed by the Camp Coordinator.
4. Please bring a plastic drinking cup or sports bottle to camp each day.
5. Parents, spray child with insect repellent and apply sunscreen thoroughly before bringing them to camp.
6. Camp counselors will notify parents at the beginning of each session regarding the days their child will need to bring swimsuit and towel for swim day.
7. Each camper will receive one Camp Cimarron t-shirt.



RAINY DAY PROCEDURES

Camp Programs WILL NOT be cancelled on rainy days!

1. If it is raining prior to the start of camp, parents will be contacted by counselors to bring their children to Oak Point Recreation Center, located at 6000 Jupiter Road.
2. If it starts to rain during camp, children will be taken to Oak Point Recreation Center, 6000 Jupiter Road. Counselors will then try to contact parents regarding the change.

Carpenter Park Recreation Center


