WHAT IS THERAPEUTIC RECREATION?

Therapeutic Recreation (TR) is the use of recreational services to improve or maintain physical, cognitive, emotional, and social functioning and to promote healthy, independent leisure life styles. The Plano Parks and Recreation Department provides year-round therapeutic programming that includes games, swimming, music, arts & crafts, and much more. Plano's TR program is designed to provide recreational opportunities for individuals with special needs and disabilities, but is open to everyone. Although these programs are considered recreational, there are many benefits that are listed throughout this program, plus many more. The programs stress choice, involvement, and self-direction while offering recreational experiences, new challenges, and socialization in a safe environment. Volunteers are on hand at many programs to assist and
