Photography Exhibit Commemorating Veterans Day Featured in Plano Municipal Center

Work by photographer and veteran John Comito is currently on exhibit at the Plano Municipal Center, 1520 K Avenue. The exhibit, entitled "By The Tigris," consists of photographs depicting images from Comito's recent tour with the U.S. Army in Iraq. An artist's reception will be held Friday, Nov. 14 from 7 to 9 p.m. in Training Room A of Plano Municipal Center.

By profession, John Comito is a police officer for the City of Addison. Having studied photography in college, he has decades of experience using the camera as a medium of expression. As he did in a body of photographic work produced during his service in military operation "Enduring Freedom" in Afghanistan, he has artfully captured images of faces, life and war in Iraq.

The exhibit will continue through December 2008 on the second and third floors of Plano Municipal Center and transfer to Plano Centre, 2000 E. Spring Creek Parkway, until March 2009. Hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
