## Plano's District 2 Neighborhood Roundtable Slated for Nov. 20

The Mayor and City Council of Plano invite Council District 2 residents to join them for a Neighborhood Roundtable discussion on Thursday, Nov. 20 from 7 to 9 p.m. at the Tom Muehlenbeck Recreation Center, 5801 W. Parker Road.

Neighborhood Roundtables are part of an ongoing outreach program to present information and answer questions regarding city services and programs. It is a working meeting where citizens help the City explore solutions to district concerns. Though the meeting is focused on District 2, all Plano residents are welcome to participate. The District 2 area is bound by the City's limit on the north, the City's limit on the south and the City's limit on the west. The eastern boundary is at Coit Road (from northern City's limit to Parker Road) and at Ohio Drive (from Parker Road to the southern City's limit).
