Plano Fire Department Holds Entrance EXAM for Fire Rescue Specialist Position

The Plano Fire Department will administer a civil service firefighter entrance examination on Monday, **October 12** at the Plano Centre. The pre-registration questionnaire, which determines eligibility to sit for the exam, is available online at www.planofire.org. The completed questionnaire must be received in the City of Plano Civil Service Office by **12:00 noon (Central Standard Time) on September 18.**

The eligibility list created from this entrance examination will be in effect for six months from the date of the examination. During this timeframe, if the Plano Fire Department has firefighter positions to fill, they will initiate the hiring process with the first names on the list. The hiring process includes a physical ability test, a personal history statement and criminal background check as well as an interview board.

To be eligible to take the entrance examination, applicants must possess a high school diploma or high school equivalency certificate (GED) and a minimum of thirty semester hours of college credit from an accredited college or university. Applicants who qualify for additional points with military service may have until the first anniversary of their hire date to meet the 30 semester hour requirement.

Plano Centre is located at 2000 E. Spring Creek Parkway – on the southwest corner of Spring Creek Parkway and Jupiter Road.
