Plano Honors Food Establishments with Safety & Sanitation Excellence Awards

As part of National Food Safety Awareness Month, the City of Plano Health Department will recognize Plano foodservice establishments Monday, Sept. 27 at 3:30 p.m. at Plano Municipal Center, 1520 K Ave. The Food Safety & Sanitation Excellence Awards are presented to establishments that have achieved and maintained the highest standards of food safety and sanitation. They are selected from the more than 1,400 permitted food establishments in Plano.

The Food Safety & Sanitation Excellence Awards have been presented annually since 1997. The tabulation period for the award is from Oct. 1 to Aug. 1. Selection of award finalists is based on routine inspection scores, types of foods prepared and served, number of meal periods per day and opening date of the establishment.

Criteria related to routine inspections included: maintaining a score of “A” on all routine inspections, zero critical violations on a routine inspection, zero valid complaints, no enforcement closures or municipal court citations. Additionally, a surprise team inspection was performed on all finalists to determine the winner in each category.
