## Plano Memorial Day Observance

The City of Plano Memorial Day Observance will be held Monday, May 31, 8:30am, Plano Municipal Center, 1520 K Avenue. Memorial Day Observance Chair Mayor Pro Tem Lee Dunlap will be joined on the dais by U. S. Congressman Ralph Hall along with other local dignitaries and representatives from all branches of the military. The Program includes musical selections by the Plano Community Band, a children's flag march, a wreath-laying ceremony, and a 21-gun salute.

Featured will be keynote speaker Leila Hunt-Willingham, the sister of Army Specialist Jason Dean Hunt, one of 13 soldiers killed when a gunman opened fire November 5, 2009 at a Fort Hood soldier readiness center. The incident also left 32 persons wounded in the worst mass shooting at a United States military base.

The Observance will be broadcast live on Plano Television Network through Time Warner Cable channel 16 and Verizon Fios channel 30/31. Replays are set for June 2 (9am), June 3 (8pm) and June 6 (1pm).
