Plano's All-American Fourth Lights Up Oak Point Park & Nature Preserve

The night sky in Plano will be glowing with a traditional fireworks display during Plano's *All-American Fourth* on Sunday, July 4.

Oak Point Park and Nature Preserve, on Spring Creek Parkway between Jupiter and Parker Roads, will be the launch site for the fireworks display. A great location to view the show is from the grounds of the Spring Creek Campus of Collin College.

Atlas Enterprises is the pyro-architect behind Plano's display. This show has been viewed as one of the premier **FREE** pyrotechnic experiences around Dallas. A live radio remote by 97.5 KLAK will provide music for your listening pleasure beginning at 7:30 p.m. Then at 9:30 p.m., a special collection of patriotic songs will be simulcast on 97.5 KLAK during the fireworks.

Families can bring lawn chairs, picnic dinners and their radios to relax on the grassy slopes of the viewing area. Concessions on site include turkey legs, sausage-on-a-stick and soft drinks offered by Ye Ole Butcher Shop. In addition, Dippin' Dots will be serving frozen treats.

Spring Creek Parkway between Jupiter and Fieldlark will be closed beginning at 4 p.m. to ensure safety. Free parking will be available at the First United Methodist Church, Collin College and the Plano Centre. Access to available parking at the Spring Creek Campus of Collin College will be from Jupiter Road, while parking at the First United Methodist Church is accessible from Parker Road. Drivers should be aware there may be delays due to interchange construction at U.S. 75 and Parker Road.
