Friday, July 2

Start the weekend holiday under the stars with the Red, White and Blues concert at the Amphitheater at Oak Point Park, 2801 E. Spring Creek Parkway. Enjoy an encore performance by Voodoo Blue, a Stevie Ray Tribute Band on Friday, July 2. The concert begins at 8 p.m. and the cost is \$15 for adults, \$12 for seniors (60 +), \$9 for children under 12 and children 5 and under are free.
