NOMINATION FORM & GUIDELINES

AWARDS & PROCEDURES

CERTIFICATE OF APPRECIATION

Awarded to any person or organization that has:

- made a contribution or an achievement that has promoted or furthered preservation in Plano in the last year; and/or
- has made a significant effort to maintain an historic property.

AWARD OF EXCELLENCE IN PRESERVATION

Awarded to a person or organization that has completed a significant and successful preservation project in the past year. This may include a restoration (residential or commercial) or new construction in an historic district.

PRESERVATION HALL OF FAME AWARD

Awarded to a person or organization (historic property owner or not) that has contributed significantly and repeatedly to preservation efforts and has demonstrated ongoing efforts above-and-beyond expectations. Previous winners of this award include (but are not limited to) Ms. Sheila Huckaby, and Ms. Lolisa Laenger, Heritage Farmstead Museum, and Mr. and Mrs. A.R. Schell, Plano ISD, Haggard Park Homeowners Association.

NOMINATION PROCEDURES

Each nomination must include a completed nomination form including a concise description (750 words or less) of the project, program, organization or individual that is being nominated.

If the nominated project involves a building, explain its historical significance, the challenges overcome, unique strategies and activities carried out, and the impact of these activities on the community.

If the nominee is an individual or organization, describe their accomplishments and contributions in the area of historic preservation.

Attach photos as desired. Before and after result photos, overall exterior images, images with people and activity around the site and images of the project in the context of the greater community are helpful. Supporting brochures, news clippings, or letters of recommendation may also be attached as desired.
