

2009 City of Plano HPRP- CSP Q & A

1. Can any agency that has experience helping individuals/families experiencing homelessness apply for City of Plano HPRP funds?

Answer:

No. Agencies submitting applications must meet the following criteria:

1) Have a minimum of 36 months experience as of June 1, 2009 providing services to persons who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless; and

(2) Experience administering HUD funded programs within the last 60 months.

2. When is the CSP due and where should it be submitted?

3. What is the distribution timeframe for City of Plano's HPRP funds?

Answer:

The City of Plano has a total of \$468,597 in HPRP funds to distribute to agencies. Agencies receiving HPRP funds will be required to sign an 18 month contract with the City of Plano. HPRP eligible expenses will be reimbursed accordingly. If an agency spends funds on eligible HPRP activities before the 18 month contract is completed, that is acceptable. The City of Plano's goal is to spend the funds as quickly as possible on qualified families/individuals in order to prevent homelessness.

4. Will there be a Pre-Proposal Conference?

Answer:

Yes. Pre-Proposal Conference will be at 10:00 am on Monday, June 22. The meeting will be held at the Plano Municipal Building located at 1520 Avenue K, Plano, TX in Training Room A.

5. Is the HPRP grant funds distributed to agencies on a reimbursement basis?

Answer:

Yes. HPRP funds will be distributed to agencies via reimbursement.
