The meeting started at 6:30pm. Monique gave the following updates on previous inquiries:

- Speed cushion caution signs were installed at the following locations:
 - Eastbound west of Greywood Ln, eastbound west of Kyle Dr., westbound west of Cherry Hill Dr., and westbound east of Cherry Hill Dr
- If seniors in the neighborhood need assistance with home and yard maintenance, residents should contact a volunteer organization called [Plain-O-Helpers](#) at 469-366-4286.
- Engineering staff is assessing erosion concerns discussed at the August 6 meeting; outcome pending.
- Public Works crews are working to clear out creek vegetation. Efforts are underway but equipment problems delayed project completion.

Following these updates from planning staff, residents heard presentations from Plano Police Officers from the Neighborhood Police Officers Unit and the Crime Prevention Unit.

NEIGHBORHOOD POLICE OFFICERS UNIT (NPO)

First, Officer Glenn answered general questions regarding:

- Curfew hours (Sun-Thurs 11pm; Fri-Sat 12am)
- Noise ordinance – loud “thumping” car stereos

Officer Glenn also discussed neighborhood survey results. He expressed the necessity for residents to watch out for suspicious activity and **call 911 for any situation**. Officer Glenn gave the following crime statistics for the Caddo Park neighborhood (stats are for the past 12 months):

- Assaults 11 (8 were family violence)
- Criminal Mischief-7 (one graffiti)
- Burglary Habitation-8
- Burglary Vehicle-12
- Theft-10
- Vehicle Theft-1
- Harassment -4
- Obscene Display -1
- Public Intoxication -3
- Narcotics -3

CRIME PREVENTION UNIT (CPU)

Next, Officer Dawson gave a general talk about Crime Prevention. Officer Dawson told residents, according to the survey, 59% of the survey respondents are interested in participating in a neighborhood crime watch group. **NOTE: This will be discussed at the next meeting, but a resident needs to initiate contact with Officer Dawson to set up a crime watch group. Planning staff will work with PD to determine if there are existing crime watch areas within the Caddo Park neighborhood project area.**
