



## Caddo Park Neighborhood Meeting Notes (09/17/09)

The meeting started at 6:30pm. Jon gave the following updates on previous inquiries:

- Potholes on Pinehurst Dr. were filled. A permanent pavement project scheduled for this area in fiscal year 09-10.
- Caddo Park assessment – Parks and Planning staff assessed the area and Parks staff determined that ambient light should be sufficient for light for the bridge that connects the walking trail to Davis Elementary.
- During Caddo Park assessment, staff dispatched park maintenance to cut and/or remove trees damaged in Caddo Park from previous storms; broken branches were obstructing the walking trail pathways.



Following these updates, Jon introduced Rick Berry, Sr. Transportation Engineer. Rick discussed the following with residents:

- There are few residential traffic complaints for Caddo Park. There are a few problem areas, primarily related to school traffic, that require PD Traffic Unit and Transportation Engineers to work together to alleviate speeding, parking and traffic circulation problems.
- The possible sight visibility concerns at Parkhaven and Custer and Stone Creek and Custer will be assessed and feedback will be given at upcoming meetings.
- Street signs are not visible in the eastbound direction on Pinehurst at Independence. Transportation Engineering will assess this concern.
- There are speeding problems on Pinehurst Dr., Lakeview Trail, and Winterplace Circle. Plano PD Traffic Unit and Transportation Engineering will address these concerns.

Next, Sergeant Brad Neal spoke with residents. Sgt. Neal shared information regarding the Traffic Unit's traffic complaint process and how officers in the unit work to address concerns. Sgt. Neal informed residents that they focus on the following (especially after a traffic enforcement request or complaint):

- High crash locations and school zones; they utilize speed volume count data to pinpoint problems; use speed trailers in problem areas; utilize beat officers to help with targeted enforcement.
- Residents mentioned concerns with high speed traffic on Roundrock Trl and Teakwood Dr. Sgt. Neal said the Traffic Unit can place traffic counter devices in these areas to determine vehicle speed and identify peak times vehicles are speeding.
