NOTE: The **Transportation Engineering Division** attended a neighborhood meeting on [March 5](#) and gave residents an update on mass transit services in Plano as well as the Safe Streets Program (a program designed to address residential traffic concerns). Following this meeting, City Council ended the Safe Streets Program (effective March 6, 2009). Cross Creek residents chose not to pursue traffic calming devices and have been informed that the program is no longer active.
