



# Cross Creek Neighborhood Meeting Notes (03/19/09)

The meeting started at 7pm with a meet and greet between city staff and residents.



Monique Coleman, Neighborhood Planner started by answering questions and providing follow-up information from the previous meeting. Afterwards, Monique turned the meeting over to [Property Standards](#) staff. Rodney Noles, Property Standards Specialist, gave a presentation highlighting the Department's goals and objectives, as well as the most frequent property standards violations they encounter on a regular basis ([click here to review presentation](#)). The presentation contains images of the violations discussed.

Next, two Parks representatives spoke with the group about Hoblitzelle Park. Residents had few questions and expressed their appreciation for the maintenance of the park. The discussion with Ed Voss, Athletics Superintendent and Kevin Murray, Admin. Athletics Superintendent prompted the following discussion topics:

- Coyotes in the creek – Parks staff suggested residents contact Animal Services. This is being addressed.

- Hoblitzelle Park will be included in the May 2009 Bond Referendum within the Athletic and Parks section of the referendum – Click links to review [preliminary bond referendum](#) and [project descriptions](#).

- Parks staff informed meeting attendees that the plastic bags that accompanied the pet waste stations have been removed as a result of a new law; this will save the city \$30,000.



- There is cracked cement on specified trail locations due to drought – this information will be passed on to Trails System Planner.
- There are no plans for Hoblitzelle Park at this time. In the future, Parks and Recreation will host resident forums to ask residents what they would like to see. Residents will be notified of these meetings.

Monique ended the meeting by showing the residents how to access certain information on various Web sites. The meeting was adjourned at 8:30pm.
