

The Love Where You Live neighborhood survey was mailed on June 23, 2011 to 1,274 households bounded by 18th Street, 14th Street, Jupiter Road, and Shiloh Road. The survey mail out area also included the Madison Estates development located at the southwest corner of 14th Street and Rigsbee Drive. By July 26, 148 residents responded to the survey making the response rate approximately 11.6%. The questions below were asked to help city staff and Love Where You Live partners gain a better understanding of the makeup of each household as well as the neighborhood overall. Please find the survey response details below.
