

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR THE ACCEPTANCE AND PROCESSING OF PETITIONS REQUESTING ADDITIONAL STREET LIGHTS WITHIN A PARTICULAR BLOCK OR NEIGHBORHOOD AND ESTABLISHING LIABILITIES FOR PAYMENT OF THE IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt a policy to be hereafter followed in accepting and processing petitions to install additional street lights within a particular block or neighborhood within the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:


Section I. The following procedures shall be followed by all persons involved in the circulation and processing of petitions requesting additional street lights within a particular block or neighborhood:

1. Placement of any additional street light shall conform to the General Street Light Policy of the City of Plano;
2. Petition forms shall be acquired from and processed by the City Engineering Office;
3. Circulation of the petitions shall be the responsibility of the initiator of the petition and the City shall not be involved in the circulation process;
4. Every attempt must be made to obtain the signatures of every property owner located within 300 feet of the proposed street light location, as measured along the street right-of-way
5. 80% of the property owners within 300 feet of the proposed street light location, as measured along the street right-of-way, must sign the petition in favor of the proposed change in order for the petition to be accepted by the City;
6. In determining the number of lots affected, the lots shown on the filed plat for the subdivision shall be used; whether a lot is occupied or not will not affect the total lot count;


7. A Registered Letter shall be sent by the City to any property owner within 300 feet of the proposed street light location, as measured along the street right-of-way, whose name does not appear on the petition in order to insure that all affected property owners are aware of the proposed change;
8. The signatures on the petition will be verified against the City tax rolls;
9. If the petition is valid under the provisions above, the City will estimate cost of the installation. After the cost estimate is determined, the Petitioners will be advised that the City will pay one-third (1/3) of the estimated cost of the installation, the balance of the cost will be borne by the Petitioners;
10. Upon presentation of two-thirds (2/3) of the estimated cost of the installation to the City, a work order will be issued to install the street light. No partial payments will be accepted. The City will not serve as a collection agency for the Petitioners.

Section II. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.


