# State-Of-The-Art Venue

This State-Of-The-Art Theater space is the result of the support of the City of Plano and the visionary leadership of the arts community. The architectural firm, Hardy-Holzmen-Pfeffier Associates, worked diligently to preserve the historic materials and style of the existing building while adding modern functionality with interior accents of color, form and material. The end result is a modern facility with a historical perspective unlike any other theater in the DFW Metroplex.

## Backstage

The two star dressing rooms are very close to the stage entrances and provide several large well-lit makeup mirrors and a bathroom with a shower. The company dressing rooms are up stairs and can be opened up into one big dressing room if needed. There are two bathrooms connected to the dressing rooms with several showers in each.



## Lobby

The 3,000 Square-Foot Lobby space is divided into four distinct areas: entrance/box office area, Donor's Lounge, main lobby and atrium. These areas provide superior traffic flow and audience comfort during performances. As well as being ideally suited for receptions, meetings, educational programming, and private parties. Separate events may be held simultaneously or the entire facility may be linked to the performance space via backstage monitors.



## Our Equipment

The Stage has a modular design to allow for customizable configurations. The theater features movable wall panels for "tuning" the acoustic properties of the space to satisfy the diverse needs of a wide variety of clients. A fully stocked lighting system, which includes LED fixtures, moving lights and various forms of dichroic color changing, provide the flexibility to illuminate any event.
