THE GOALS OF A POLICE MOTORCYCLE TRAINING PROGRAM ARE IMPROVED OFFICER SAFETY,REDUCTION OF ACCIDENTS, AND REDUCTION OF LIABILITY.

THESE COMPETITIONS ARE BASED ON TRAINING THAT MOTORCYCLE OFFICERS RECEIVE BECAUSE OF THE JOB REQUIREMENTS OF A MOTORCYCLE OFFICER. THEY MUST FIRST BE POLICE OFFICERS, THEN ACCOMPLISH THEIR PRIMARY JOB RESPONSIBILITIES WHICH MAY ENCOMPASS TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT, ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION, TRAFFIC CONTROL, VIP MOTORCADES, ESCORTS.

BECAUSE OF THE NATURE OF THE DUTIES REQUIRED OF A POLICE OFFICER, AND THE TYPE OF RIDING SITUATIONS THEY WILL ENCOUNTER IN THEIR DAY TO DAY DUTIES, THE RIDER'S SKILLS AND ABILITIES MUST BE GREATER THAN THE GENERAL RIDING PUBLIC.

THESE TRAINING COMPETITIONS PROVIDE THE MOTORCYCLE OFFICERS WITH ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR IMPROVING AND MAINTAINING THEIR RIDING SKILLS, WHILE AT THE SAME TIME SHARING TRAINING AND RIDING INFORMATION WITH THEIR FELLOW OFFICERS.

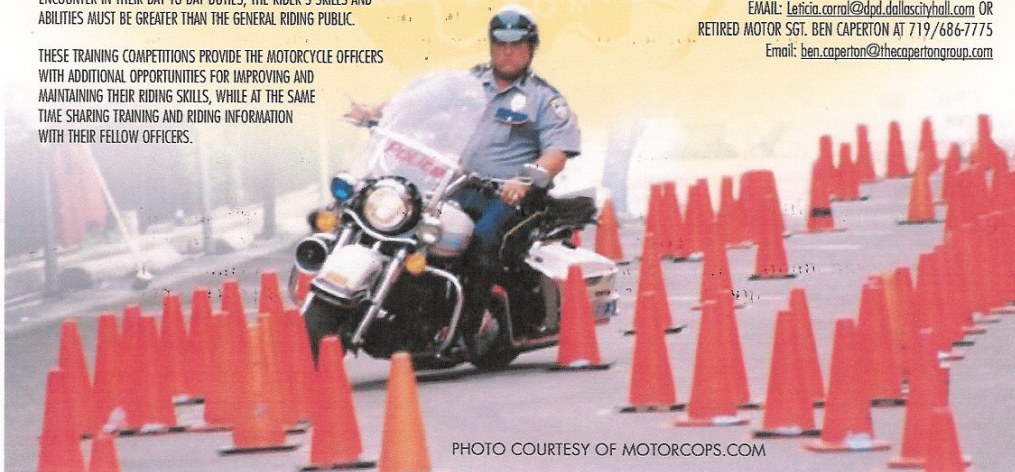
