ROBBERY

On January 23, 2007 at approximately 2:34 a.m., Plano Police Officers responded to a Robbery at a construction site in the 9300 block of Coit Road. Upon Officers arrival it was determined that several construction trailers had been broken into. Officers located the security guard a short time later at Centennial Hospital where he had gone to call for help.

The security officer at the construction site stated that he had been awakened by a loud noise as a subject broke the window and entered the trailer where he was sleeping. The suspects tied up the security officer and took his cell phone to prevent him from calling for help. The security guard described the suspects as two Hispanic males but could not give an age range or clothing description. The suspects entered several trailers by cutting the locks with torches and removed numerous equipment and tools. The suspects then fled the area in vehicles.

The security officer ran on foot to the nearby hospital where he called for help. He did not receive any injuries during the robbery. It is unknown how much inventory and equipment had been removed during this incident. This investigation is still ongoing.
