### **DEATH INVESTIGATION**

On December 9, 2007 at approximately 8:00 a.m., Plano Police Officers responded to a Disturbance Call in the 3000 block of Bandolino Lane.

The complainant advised a Public Safety Communications 9-1-1 Operator that a male and a female were behind his residence and the female was being assaulted by the male.

The complainant further advised that he confronted the two individuals behind his residence with a handgun and ordered the male suspect to stop the assault. The suspect then allegedly entered the backyard of the complainant and again was ordered to stop. The complainant retreated into his home and secured the door to his residence. The complainant reported that the suspect attempted to follow him into his residence by allegedly breaking through the rear door.

As the suspect allegedly entered the home through the rear door of the residence, the female victim also attempted to detain the suspect. The complainant reported that he continued to order the suspect to stop. The complainant advised that the suspect appeared to be out of control and staggering. After the suspect fled through

the front door of the residence the complainant reported that the suspect collapsed in his front yard.

Upon Officers arrival, the suspect was located lying face down in front of the residence. Officers immediately handcuffed the suspect and placed him in an upright position to assess his condition. Plano Fire personnel arrived on scene and transported the suspect to a local area hospital where he was pronounced deceased shortly after arrival.

The suspect, Qwame Lombardo, a 25-year old black male, was the husband of the female assault victim. The initial disturbance began in the 3600 block of Big Horn Trail where the suspect and the victim reside.

This investigation is currently on-going. The Collin County Medical Examiner will determine the suspect's cause of death in this incident.
