Aggravated Robbery

At approximately 6:44 a.m., Officers of the Plano Police Department responded to a possible robbery that had occurred in the 3100 block of Timber Brook Drive. The resident at the location advised they were allegedly approached outside their residence by a subject who had a handgun and took his personal belongings. At 7:15 a.m., Officers received a second call of a robbery in the 800 block of Harvest Glen Drive. The resident there alleged they had also been confronted outside their residence by a subject at gunpoint demanding money. This victim informed Plano Police Officers that the subject fled the scene in a vehicle driven by a second subject. At 7:41 a.m., Officers received a third report of a robbery. This incident occurred in the 1600 block of Commerce Drive where it was alleged that a black male approached a resident as he had returned home and robbed him at gunpoint as the victim was about to exit his vehicle. Plano Police Officers were able to locate the suspect vehicle traveling east on West Park Blvd and initiated a traffic stop. After the vehicle had stopped, officers ordered the occupants out of their vehicle. The occupants refused. As Plano Police Officers approached the suspect vehicle, it began to speed away from the scene, at which time a Plano Police Officer fired his weapon flattening the rear tire.

The vehicle continued fleeing the scene with the flat tire south on U.S. 75 and into Dallas. As Plano Police Officers were pursuing the suspect vehicle, they observed several items being thrown from the suspect vehicle. Several items, including a handgun, were recovered and may possibly be linked to the crime. The pursuit ended in South Dallas after the suspect vehicle rammed into a Plano Police marked squad car. The suspects were taken into custody without incident at that location.

The suspects were identified as Eric Demetrick White, a 22 year old black male from Dallas, Texas and Amber Sue Oden, a 19 year old black female from Hutchins, Texas. Each suspect has been charged with 3 counts of Aggravated Robbery and 1 count of Evading Arrest. The suspects are currently in Collin County Detention Center in McKinney, Texas. Mug shots are not being released at this time for investigative reasons. The investigation is currently on-going.
