On July 7, 2007 Motorcycle Unit Officer Wes Hardy was killed in a traffic crash at the intersection of Independence and Russell Creek Drive. The police substation, located at the Joint Use Facility, houses the Plano Police Department's Traffic Unit and was Officer Hardy's duty station.
