Former Police Chief James Bryan (J.B.) Toler passed away on Thursday, August 27, 2009 in Allen TX. He joined the Plano Police Department in 1959. During his 16-year career at the Department, he served as one of the first policemen with the City of Plano and as Police Chief from 1961 until he retired in 1975.
