MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH

On January 15, 2010 at approximately 2:45 a.m., Plano Police Officers responded to a Motor Vehicle Crash with Injuries in the 6900 block of Central Expressway.

Preliminary investigation revealed that a Ford F-150, traveling eastbound on Legacy Drive, had disregarded a red traffic control signal. As a result, the truck struck a marked Ford Crown Victoria police vehicle. The police vehicle had been traveling northbound on the service road of Central Expressway, attempting a left turn onto westbound Legacy Drive on a green light.

The driver of the pick-up truck is an off-duty Plano Police Officer and has been with the Plano Police Department for approximately 6 years. The Officer driving the marked police vehicle has been with the Department for approximately 2 years. Both Officers were transported to a local area hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH - UPDATE

The Plano Police Officers involved in this incident are as follows:

Officer Ray Wildes, 37 years old, is a 6 year veteran of the Plano Police Department and the driver of the Ford F-150.
