**IMPROPER VIDEO RECORDING**

The Plano Police Department is investigating an offense which occurred at the City of Plano's Oak Point Recreation Center, located at 6000 Jupiter Road.

In this offense, a recording device disguised to look like a typical bathroom air freshener was attached to the wall in a family changing area, to surreptitiously record individuals in the changing room.

The attached photographs are of a person who the Plano Police Department is attempting to identify. He is described as a white male, 30-40 years old, 5'8"-6'0" tall with a medium build. He has short brown hair with sideburns and a bald spot on the crown of his head. Also attached is a photograph of the recording device that was placed inside the family changing area.

The Plano Police Department is asking for the public's help in identifying the subject in this incident. **IMPROPER VIDEO RECORDING - UPDATE**

On December 5, 2011 at approximately 10:30 a.m., a suspect was arrested in connection with this offense. Christopher Scott Furber, a 43-year old white male from Garland, TX has been charged with Improper Photography or Visual Recording. Furber is being held in the Collin County Detention Center on a \$25,000 bond.

This investigation is currently on-going.
